<input type="checkbox"/> Confirm Admissions You will receive notification of admissions approximately four weeks after you submit your complete application. <input type="checkbox"/> Commitment Fee/Deposit Adirondack requires \$40 matriculation and \$250 housing deposits once you have decided to attend. Submitting early will hold your spot and deposits are fully refundable until May 1st.	Contact Info	Deadline/Notes
<input type="checkbox"/> Set Up Email Free campus Email accounts (accountname@wolfmail.sunyacc.edu) are automatically assigned to all students registered in credit-bearing courses. Find your account name and password under the Personal Information tab in your Banner Account. Accounts remain active as long as a student is continuously enrolled at the college. For those graduating, transferring to other institutions, or choosing not to continue their coursework, accounts are deactivated two weeks after the last final exam for a given semester. Results from these Accuplacer tests are used to place students in first-semester math and English courses where you will have the greatest opportunity to succeed. Math placement test scores are valid for two years and math tests will need to be retaken if math courses are not taken during that period. <input type="checkbox"/> Check for Verification Some students will need to provide additional documents for the college to process their financial aid, a process called verification. When a student is selected for verification, SUNY Adirondack will send a tracking letter formally requesting the documents and enclosing the verification worksheet. The necessary documents are also listed under "Requirements" in the Financial Aid section of your Self-Service Banner account. Complete the verification form and also log into your FAFSA to transfer your family's updated tax forms. If it doesn't work online, you will need to request a copy of your tax transcript at www.irs.gov . Visit http://www.sunyacc.edu/financialaidforms for more information.
